## Statement of Principle

1. Palouse Care Network, Inc. is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ (through His Church). Therefore, Palouse Care Network embodied in its board members, staff, and volunteers, is committed to presenting the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ both in word and in deed. Commensurate with this purpose, those who labor as Palouse Care Network board members, staff, and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
2. Palouse Care Network is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about prenatal development, pregnancy options and information regarding sexually transmitted diseases and sexually transmitted infections.
3. Palouse Care Network is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust and providing information/services and eschewing any form of deception in its corporate advertising or individual conversations. Palouse Care Network denounces and forbids any form of deception in its corporate advertising or individual conversations with its clients.
4. Palouse Care Network is committed to assisting women to carry to term by providing full medical disclosure regarding their pregnancy as well as emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women and men may face the future with hope, and plan constructively for themselves and for their children.
5. Palouse Care Network does not discriminate in providing services because of age, race, income, nationality, religious affiliation, disability or other arbitrary circumstances.
6. Palouse Care Network is committed to providing a safe place that will not profit from the reproductive and lifestyle choices our clients make. Therefore, Palouse Care Network provides medically accurate information but does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortions, abortifacients or contraceptives.
7. Palouse Care Network offers advocacy and specialized medical services free of charge. (Clients may pay applicable lab and prescription fees.)
8. Palouse Care Network is committed to creating awareness of the needs of pregnant women and that abortion compounds human need rather than resolve it. Palouse Care Network's mission of promoting a culture of life extends to promoting the value of all human life.
9. Palouse Care Network recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion, but is not biased toward adoption when compared to other life-saving alternatives. We are independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. Palouse Care Network receives no payment of any kind from these agencies, does not enter into contractual relationships with them, and does not share combined office space. Adoption agencies are not established under the auspices of Palouse Care Network. Palouse Care Network neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions but may facilitate connections with adoption agencies at the written request of the client.
